Pool Rules:

When signing in, the lifeguard will request driver's license/ID of the responsible adult and ask adults to sign in for the group with the following info: Name, Pass #, /Address, # adults, # kids, & time arrived.

*Dates & Times: Memorial Day Weekend thru Labor Day Weekend
12 Noon - 8pm Weekdays, Weekends & Holidays*

- Safety and consideration of others is of primary concern.
- Current Owners, Residents and their guests in good standing (*dues are current*) with the Association are invited to use the pool. Properties that fall behind on their dues during the pool season will be placed on a "No-Swim" list provided to the lifeguard and turned away until paid in full.
- Enter and exit by the gate only. You must present your pass and sign in with the lifeguard on duty.
- Swimming and/or use of the pool area is permitted only when lifeguard is on duty.
- Children not permitted without an adult or guardian over 18, who must remain present at all times. Residents must be 18 years of age or older to bring a guest (*limit of 2 guests per household, per day*)
- Children will be asked to pass a "swimming test" or remain in the shallow end.
- No alcoholic beverages, illegal substances or glass containers are permitted in the pool area. Food is permitted in the picnic area as long as all trash is placed in appropriate containers before leaving.
- No diving, horseplay, running, smoking, loud music, foul language or inappropriate behavior is permitted in the pool area or clubhouse. No rafts or floatation devices are permitted in the pool.
- No pets are allowed inside the fenced pool area.
- Bathrooms must be kept clean or the clubhouse will be closed to avoid damage and/or unsanitary conditions which may affect the safe and continued operation of the pool for the current season.
- Infants/Toddlers must wear an approved swimming diaper such as "Little Swimmers" or rubber pants over their diapers.
- The lifeguard on duty or the Homeowners Association may apply other rules. Those who do not follow the rules and/or obey the lifeguard will be asked to leave and continued abuse or disregard may result in loss of pool privileges for the remainder of the season.
- ***Please remember to return your pool pass to the lifeguard or the office at the end of each swim season as missing passes will incur a \$5.00 fee.***
